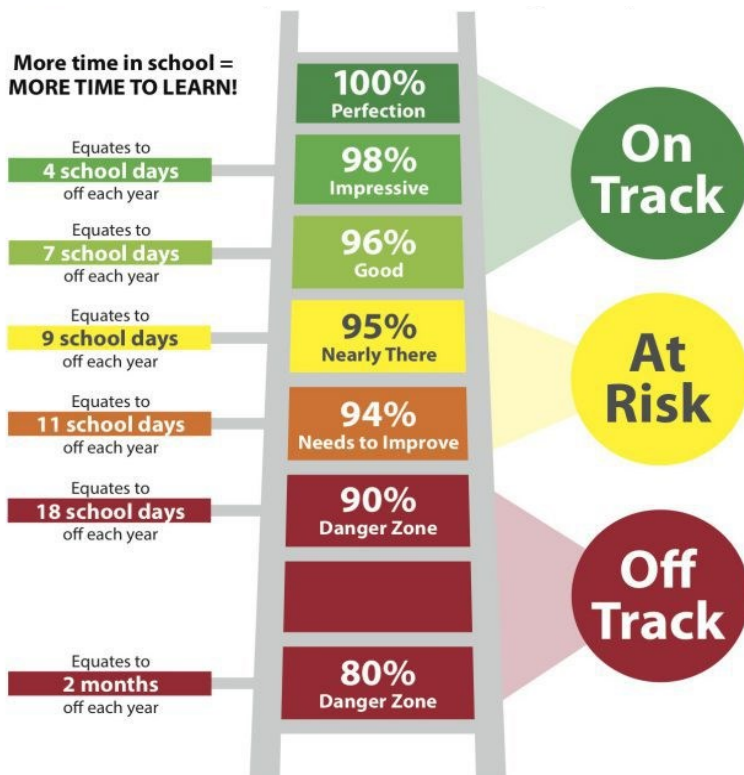

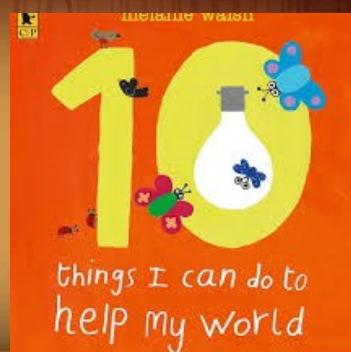
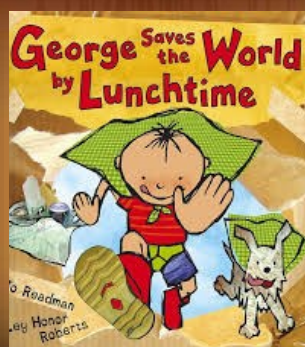
Books build a stairway to your imagination

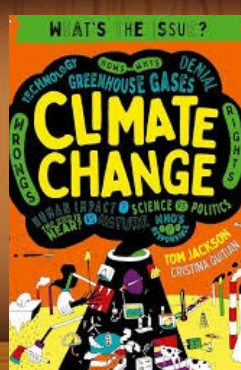
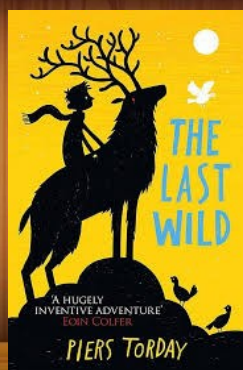
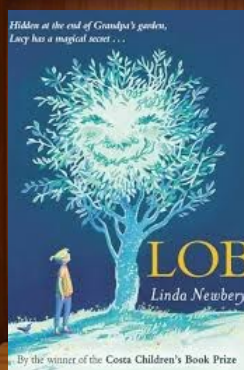
