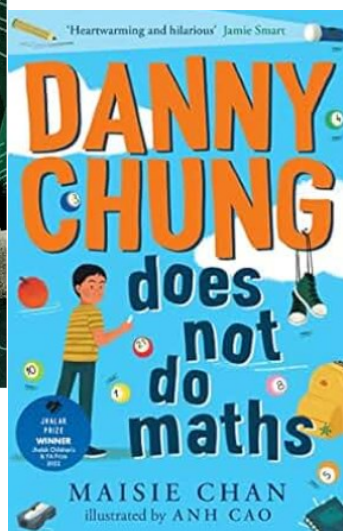
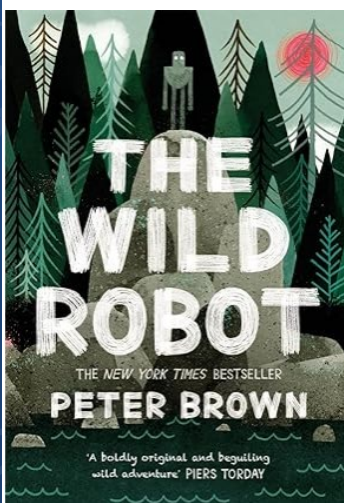
SPRING TERM 1 2025

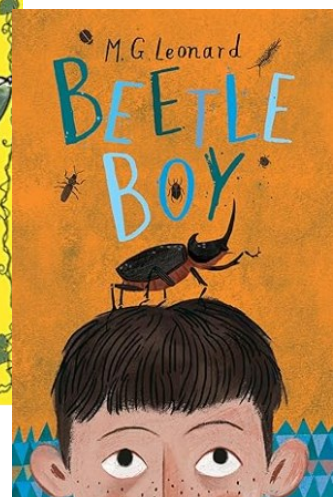
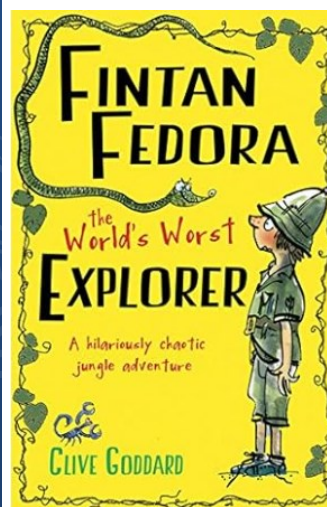
Topics we will be learning about:
