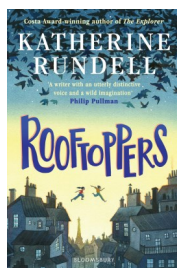
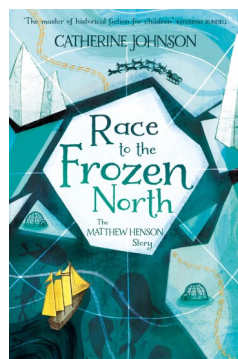
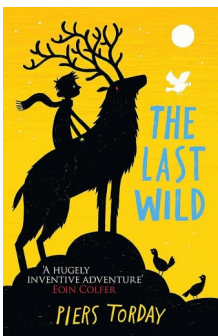
SPRING TERM 1 2025

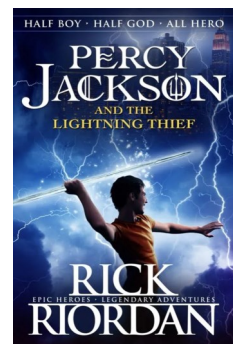
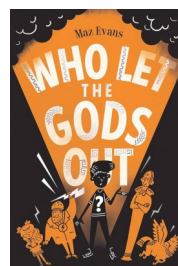
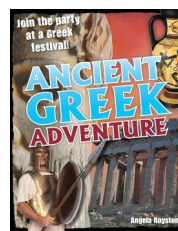
## Topics we will be learning about:
