Dear Families

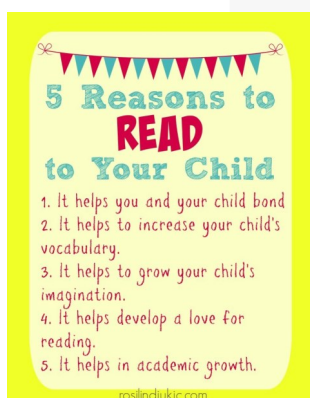
This is a long half term and we appreciate the children are all tired. Please do keep good attendance right to the end of term. It's important that children come to school every day so they don't fall behind in their learning.

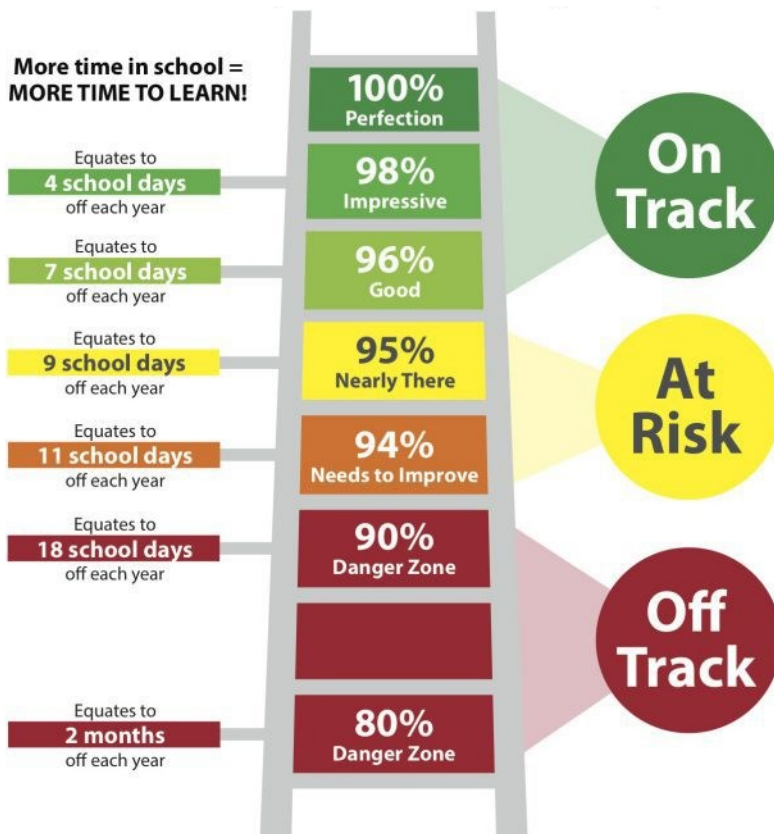
