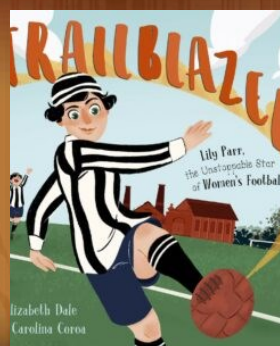
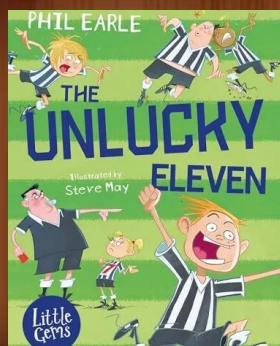
Whether you read to your child or they're old enough to read themselves, **just 20 minutes of reading a day is enough to have positive impact on their educational and personal development.**

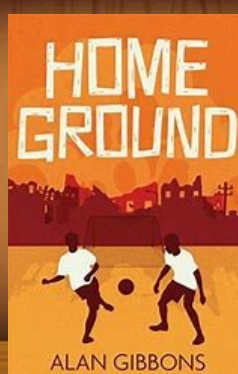
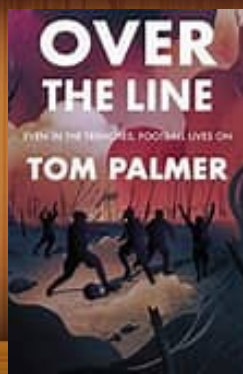
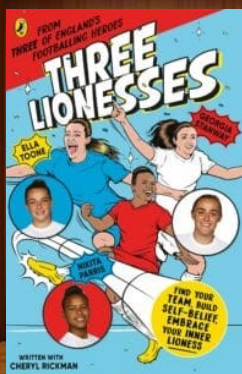
